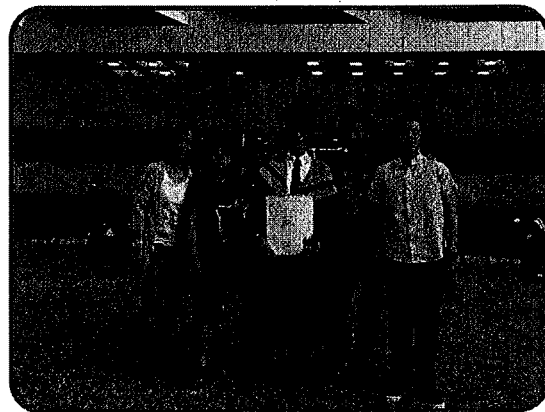
OUR VISION FOR ERICA
